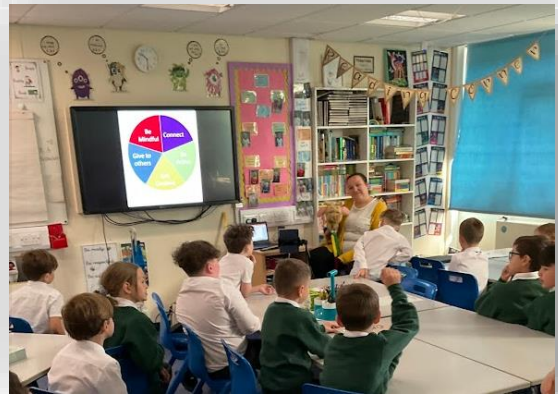

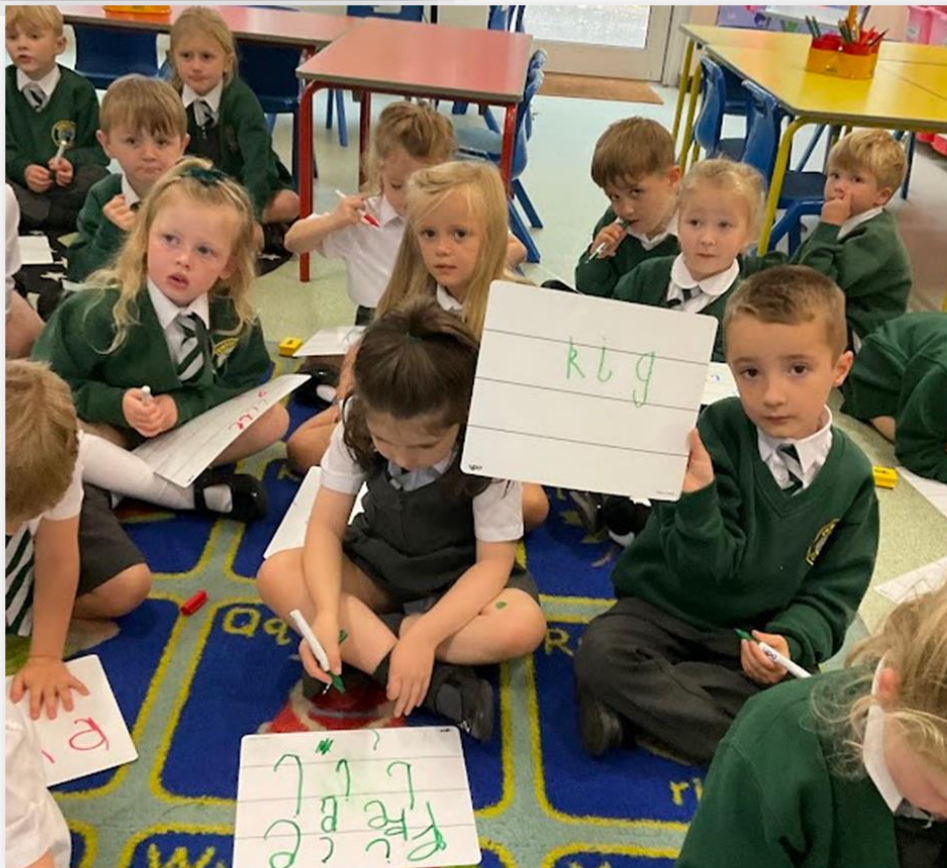
Welcome to Our New Reception Children!
